1838 Reverend Robert Grey dies of Typhus

 Grade I Listed Building built in 1719, the first Parish Church of Old Sunderland. Housed the old Town's Council Chamber and Library. Now a venue for concerts and events.

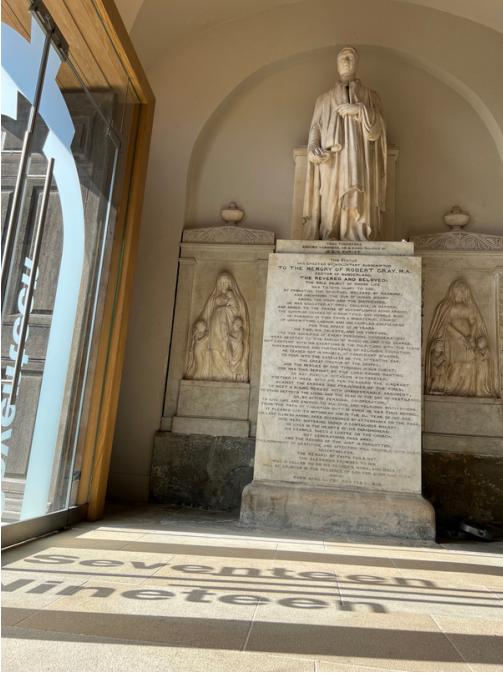

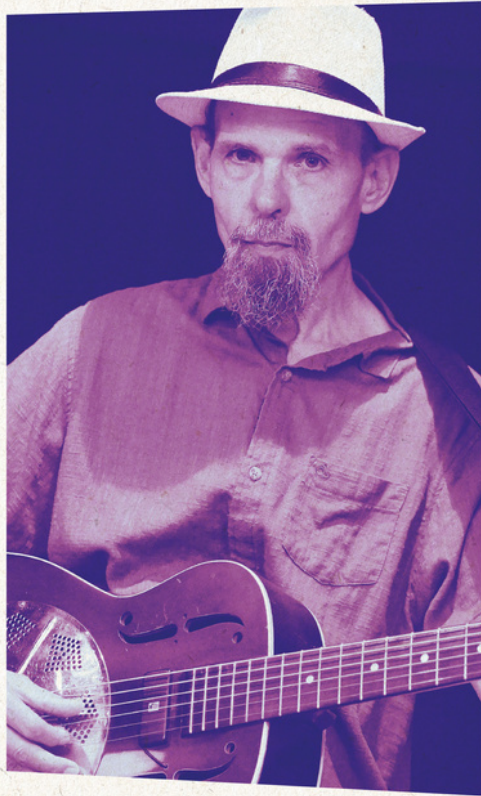
