Our Venue

This is Seventeen Nineteen, formerly known as Holy Trinity Church.

We are open to the public Wednesday, Thursday and Friday from 10am to 4pm.

Parking

There is ample on-street parking beside the venue, as well as a large parking area just a few hundred yards down Church Street East.

The entrance is completely flat, with a dropped curb at the main gate.



The Main Door

This is the main entrance to the building. There are other doors that are used by staff, but this is the main public entrance.

Wheelchair Access

The ground floor is wheelchair accessible up to the chancel steps. The upper floors are only accessible via staircase.

The doorways are wide and the door handles are low.



Our Staff

Our staff members wear red lanyards with photo ID name badges.

We are here to help you during your visit – so don't hesitate to ask if you have any questions.

Quiet Times

The church is often quiet, however, we sometimes put on special events like lectures, live music and family activities.

We post the activities coming up on social media every Monday for you to plan your visit.



The Front Desk Area

This is Kim. She sits at our front desk and greets everyone that comes inside.

Kim is very friendly and knows a lot about the venue and our events.

Kim also answers the telephone and responds to questions on social media.

If you have questions before your visit, contact us and Kim will do her best to help.



The Font

The church font and cover have been here since the church was built.

Many of the fixtures and features in the church are over 300 years old. These objects are precious to us and can be very fragile.

Handle with Care

We would like to preserve the church for people to enjoy for another 300 years.

Help us to do this by being respectful. Speak to a member of staff before touching things and do not run around in the space.




The Nave

This is the largest space in the building and where we have the majority of our activities and events.

The large ceiling and stone surfaces in this space reflect sounds. This effect can cause a lot of extra noise during events that may be overwhelming. If you need to take a break, use the vestry or the library rooms to cool off.

Our Events

If there are activities happening in the space during opening hours you can usually still come inside, look around, buy drinks and sit at the cafe tables. If you are unsure, speak to a member of staff.



The Café

The café can be found in the nave. We sell a small range of cakes and snacks as well as hot and cold drinks.

More substantial food can be bought in for groups by prior arrangement.

We sometimes have volunteers helping out at the café. Our volunteers may be building their confidence and work skills, so please be kind.

Bar

Alcohol is for sale during our evening events – we may ask to see proof of ID if you look under 25.



Activities and Events

Our space is used for a variety of different things.

During the day you might find we have a:

- Craft class
- Business meeting
- Building tour
- Family games activity
- Art installation
- Community lecture

During evenings and weekends we could have:

- Live music
- Theatre
- A wedding reception
- Cinema



The Upper Floors

The upstairs gallery and library room is up one of two old staircases. There are no lifts in the building. Use the staircase pictured if you want to avoid uneven steps.

Toilets

We have three toilets, all located on the ground floor. Each toilet is a single cubicle. They are not gender specific. One of our toilets is a accessible toilet:



Beyond the Gallery

This staircase leads to our office, which has a white door - shown in this picture. This area is for staff only, so the door is always locked.

In some special circumstances we take people up into the bell tower – to repair the clock for instance, or, when we ring the bells.

These visits are rare, as its not safe for the general public to be up there.
