

Bristol and the Cotswolds

We also get up close and personal with his work at the RSC and enjoy a stay in a 16th-century manor house.

The Landscape of Capability Brown

On these one-day tours we celebrate 300 years since the birth of Lancelot 'Capability' Brown, considered the 'Shakespeare of gardening'. We discover some of England's most alluring landscapes, visiting captivating churches, follies and historic houses whilst taking in breathtaking views.

The Art of Graffiti: Medieval Wallpaintings to Banksy Bristol, Somerset and Wiltshire


