Explore one of our churches to see if you can find these five common features!



**Ogee the Owl wants you to look for ...
the font**

The font is used in baptisms, the ceremony where water is sprinkled onto a person's forehead.



**Spires the Spider wants you to look for ...
the lectern**

The lectern is often shaped like an eagle, with the Bible resting on its outstretched wings.



**Mullion the Mouse wants you to look for ...
the altar**

The altar table is where Christians share bread and wine.



**Cloisters the Cat wants you to look for ...
the cross**

The cross is the most important symbol of Christianity.



**Belfry the Bat wants you to look for ...
the pulpit**

The leader of the church service stands in the pulpit to speak to everyone.
